The mission of the National Day of Prayer organization is to mobilize unified public prayer for America. The annual observation is held on the first Thursday of May. It invites people of all

faiths to pray for the Nation. The day was created in 1952 by President Truman. Requesting prayers for our nation goes back to the founding fathers in 1775, when they requested a day of prayer for our new nation. Each year the president signs a proclamation, encouraging all Americans to pray. Last year all 50 state governors, plus governors of several U.S. territories signed proclamations. This day stands as a call for us to humbly come before God, seeking His guidance for our leaders and His grace upon us as a people. It is as important for our nation today as it was in the beginning of our nation. It is estimated that over 2 million people attended more than 30,000 observances last year. People stopped their activities and gathered for prayer.
