**Sunday School this Fall: Reflecting God’s Light**

*Jesus said in Matthew 5:14-16:*

**Carolyn McQuillan Leading:** Adult Bible Class beginning September 12—We will begin studying the book of Isaiah from the series by the Concordia Publishing House “God’s Word For Today”. If you are interested you may call the church office and/or leave a message for Carolyn McQuillan.

**Pastor Marty Leading:** The Book of Exodus. Join pastor Marty as we do a deep dive into the book that gives us the story of Moses, the plagues, the escape from Egypt and the 10 commandments.
